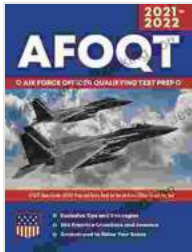

Get help from a tutor.

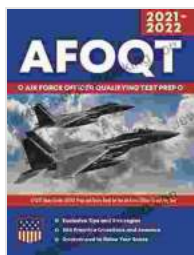
If you are struggling with a particular section, consider getting help from a tutor.

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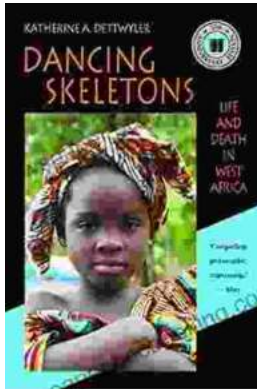
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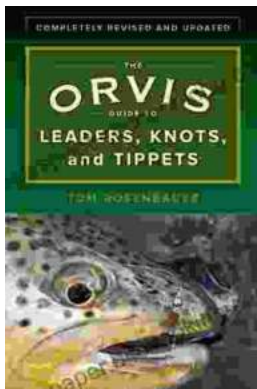
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
