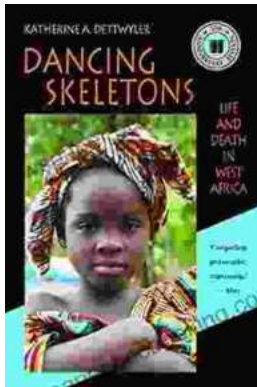
- Babe Ruth retired from baseball in 1935 with a lifetime batting average of .342, 714 home runs, and 2,214 RBIs.

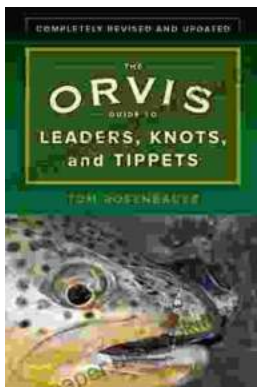
