Instructions

- 1. Cast on 96 stitches.
- 2. Knit 2 rows.

3. Begin the lace pattern: *K2, yo, k2tog, yo, repeat from * to the end of

the row.

4. Knit 2 rows.

5. Repeat rows 3-4 until the beanie measures 5 inches from the cast-on

edge.

6. Begin the decreases: *K2tog, k2, repeat from * to the end of the row.

7. Knit 1 row.

8. Repeat row 6 until there are 12 stitches remaining on the needle.

9. Cut the yarn, leaving a 6-inch tail. Thread the tail through the

remaining stitches and pull tight to close the beanie.

10. Weave in the loose ends.

Finished Measurements

Circumference: 14 inches

Length: 5 inches

Gauge

20 stitches and 28 rows = 4 inches in lace pattern

Care Instructions

Hand wash in cold water and lay flat to dry.

Additional Notes

This pattern is perfect for using up leftover yarn. You can adjust the size of the beanie by changing the number of stitches you cast on. You can also adjust the length of the beanie by knitting more or less rows.
