Row 44: Knit 7 stitches, bind off 10 stitches.

Row 45: Knit 6 stitches, bind off 10 stitches.

Row 46-47: Knit all stitches.

To make the heel:

Row 48: Knit 10 stitches, turn.

Row 49: Knit 9 stitches, turn.

Row 50: Knit 8 stitches, turn.

Row 51: Knit 7 stitches, turn.

Row 52: Knit 6 stitches, turn.

Row 53: Knit 5 stitches, turn.

Row 54: Knit 4 stitches, turn.

Row 55: Knit 3 stitches, turn.

Row 56: Knit 2 stitches, turn.

Row 57: Knit 1 stitch, turn.

Row 58: Knit 1 stitch, bind off 9 stitches.

To make the foot:

Row 59: Knit 10 stitches, pick up and knit 9 stitches from the heel, knit 10 stitches.

Row 60-70: Knit all stitches.

Row 71: Knit 20 stitches, bind off 10 stitches.

Row 72: Knit 19 stitches, bind off 10 stitches.

Row 73: Knit 18 stitches, bind off 10 stitches.

Row 74: Knit 17 stitches, bind off 10 stitches.

Row 75: Knit 16 stitches, bind off 10 stitches.

Row 76-77: Knit all stitches.

To make the top:

Row 78: Knit 20 stitches, turn.

Row 79: Knit 19 stitches, turn.

Row 80: Knit 18 stitches, turn.

Row 81: Knit 17 stitches, turn.

Row 82: Knit 16 stitches, turn.

Row 83: Knit 15 stitches, turn.

Row 84: Knit 14 stitches, turn.

Row 85: Knit 13 stitches, turn.

Row 86: Knit 12 stitches, turn.

Row 87: Knit 11 stitches, turn.

Row 88: Knit 10 stitches, turn.

Row 89: Knit 9 stitches, turn.

Row 90: Knit 8 stitches, turn.

Row 91: Knit 7 stitches, turn.

Row 92: Knit 6 stitches, turn.

Row 93: Knit 5 stitches, turn.

Row 94: Knit 4 stitches, turn.

Row 95: Knit 3 stitches, turn.

Row 96: Knit 2 stitches, turn.

Row 97: Knit 1 stitch, turn.

Row 98: Knit 1 stitch, bind off 19 stitches.

Finishing Touches

Once you've finished knitting both slippers, it's time to add the final touches and bring your cozy creation to life.

Weaving in Ends: Use a yarn needle to weave in any loose ends, securing the yarn and giving your slippers a clean and polished finish.

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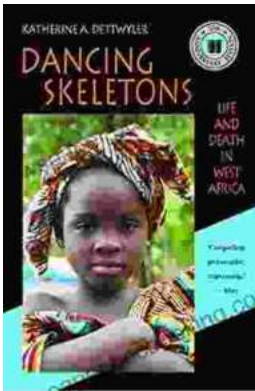
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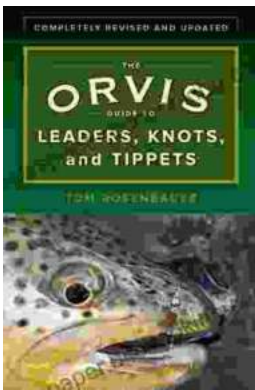
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
